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| <p>Literacy</p> |  | <p>Primary 1 - Can you spot different sounds in your environment?</p> <p>Primary 2 – Can you draw a picture of your favourite place in your community? Write some sentences about it.</p> | <p>Primary 1 – Can you write your name?</p> <p>Primary 2 – How many different words can you associate with the seasons Summer and Autumn? Can you use your sounds to write these down?</p> | <p>Read a story, comic or newspaper with an adult and show off your sounds, blending and reading!</p> |
| <p>Numeracy</p> |  | <p>Primary 1 - Can you count forwards and backwards to 10? Start at different places, not always at zero. Try counting up to a bigger number to increase difficulty.</p> <p>Primary 2 – Use 'Topmarks' online to to practice your addition within 10. 20 or 100.</p> | <p>Primary 1 - How many different numbers can you spot in your environment? Can you read the number Where did you find it? Can you take a photograph of it?</p> <p>Primary 2 - Go on a pattern hunt around your house. Take photos or draw pictures of the patterns you find.</p> | <p>Primary 1 - Practise writing the digits 0-9 with as many different mediums as you can. Be as creative as you want!!</p> <p>Primary 2 - Go on a shape hunt around your house or in your garden/outdoors. How many different shapes can you find? Can you name them?</p> |
| <p>STEAM (science, art, technology)</p> |  | <p>Make a junk model of someone or somewhere that is special to you.</p> | <p>Practise using patterns in transient art. Go outside, can you use leaves, sticks, stones etc to create patterns?</p> | <p>Can you create a picture of four different trees representing the different seasons – spring, summer, autumn and winter?</p> |
| <p>ICT</p> |  | <p>Play 'Obb and Bob' on the Letters and Sounds Website.</p> | <p>Access YouTube with an adult and practise singing the jolly phonics songs to practise your sounds. Follow the YouTube link at the bottom of the page.</p> | <p>Use a paint app on the computer/laptop/ipad/phone to create a picture of your family! This will help to build your concentration and fine motor skills.</p> |
| <p>Health & Wellbeing</p> |  | <p>Take a walk around your community with your family. Talk to your family about what you can see and do! Can you share your experience with the class?</p> | <p>Learn to tie your shoe laces with help from an adult or older sibling.</p> | <p>Play a boardgame at home, practice your turn taking and following rules.</p> |
