9.15am	<p>Arriving at Edinburgh Zoo</p> <p>We're here! Take some time to study the map of the zoo. This has been posted onto <i>See-Saw</i>. See if you can answer the questions below about the map.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Can you find the car park?2. Can you point to the zoo entrance? Can you name any animals you might see when you come out of the entrance?3. There are some symbols at the side of the map. These are some important areas that people might need to be aware of when they visit. Have a look at the symbols and learn what they mean.4. Which animal would you most like to learn about today?
