<p>Topic</p> 	<p>Hinduism: Find out more about the importance of symbolism in Hinduism and find out more about what each symbol means.</p> <p>After reading 'Hindu Symbolism', you can either complete the worksheet included in files/on the app or you can create your own Sway, PowerPoint, Word document or poster containing all the information about the symbols.</p> <p>Once you have done this, I would like you to design your own symbol. Think about how you can put your personality, hobbies, interests and name into one, clear symbol.</p>	<p>Hinduism: The story of Rama and Sita is one of the most important stories of the Hindu faith.</p> <p>Watch this video from BBC Religion - https://www.bbc.co.uk/programmes/p06ptdgh which tells you the story in a beautiful animation.</p> <p>Now, create a storyboard/comic strip about the story of Rama and Sita</p> <p>OR</p> <p>Create a piece of art work inspired by Rama and Sita</p> <p>OR</p> <p>Rewrite the story of Rama and Sita from a different point of view.</p>	<p>Hinduism: Complete your ongoing research about Hinduism and put it together into a PowerPoint, Sway, Word document or poster.</p> <p>You could include a quiz at the end of your research to check everyone has understood!</p> <p>Remember to use your own words rather than copy and paste from the internet.</p>
<p>Expressive Arts</p> 	<p>Art: In this task, you are going to concentrate on creating a one point perspective drawing. I would like you to draw your name and some shapes in one point perspective. There are some examples in Teams or on the app to help you.</p> <p>This video will help you to understand the different steps you should</p>	<p>Music: Create your own Samba band with the Royal Scottish National Orchestra (RNSO) at home.</p> <p>This is a really fun and creative activity!
