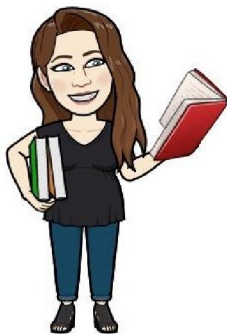
## Numeracy
