Sequencing a Story

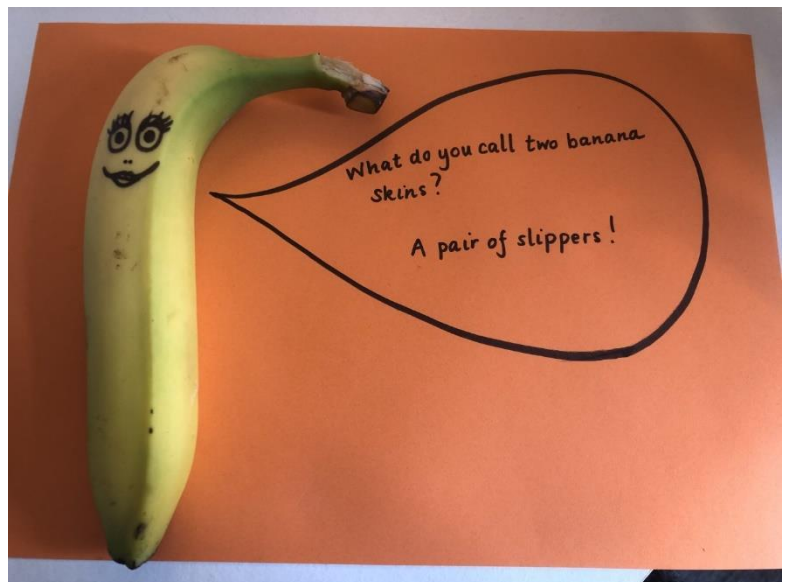
There will be a worksheet on See-Saw on which you can order the events of the story.
