6. How did the caterpillar get out of the cocoon?

7. Can you think of other animals that go through a change just like the caterpillar?

Word of the Week

Our word of the week this week is 'nibbled'.

- 1. Can you tell me how many syllables the word has?
- 2. Can you tell an adult what the word means? Where can you check the meaning of the word?
- 3. Can you think of other words that mean the same?
- 4. Can you try to write the word in a sentence?
