Hello boys and girls! Today's tasks are set below. Like yesterday, we have a literacy and numeracy based activity, as well as an additional activity linked to our school trip on Thursday!

<u>Literacy</u>

1. For your first task today, you are going to create some speech bubbles for some of the crayons. Choose 3 colours of crayon and draw them in your jotter. Add a speech bubble and inside, write what you think they may be saying.



For example, the speech bubble for black might say 'Stop using me for outlines!' Notice how I used an exclamation mark because I was shouting.

Try your best today to sound out each word yourself.

2. Next there will be a summer wordsearch activity on See-Saw.

3. Finally, you are being asked to design your own ice cream. You should think carefully about which flavours you would add to your perfect ice cream, and which toppings you would like. You can then draw a picture of your ice cream onto the activity or into your jotter.



Numeracy

You learned all about symmetry back in January with Miss. Potter. As a refresher, there will be a symmetry activity on See-Saw.

We also learned about patterns way back at the beginning of Primary 1/2. Today, you can complete the simple pattern activity on See-Saw.
