For today's task, I'd like you to write about **what you think happens to the stick Stanley throws into the water**. Do you think it washed up somewhere and someone found it? Or did an animal use it for something? Before you begin, talk to someone about the ideas you have and plan your story.


You can then begin writing your story. Remember to say your sentence(s) out loud to make sure they make sense before you begin writing. Always start with a capital letter, use finger spaces between words, and end each sentence with a full stop.

When you are finished, create an illustration for your writing. Imagine your story has been included as an extra page in the book. What would the picture look like? Make it as detailed as possible.

Other writing activities you may do today include;

- 1. Using sticks to practise your letter and number formation in sand or mud.
- 2. Practising formation using Doorway Online.
- 3. Practise writing your full name.
