You may need help from an adult with sounding out the different parts of your alien.</p>	<p>Read a book, newspaper, comic with an adult. Impress them with your sounds, blending and reading!</p>	<p>Write an imaginative story or sentence about an alien. Add a picture at the end!</p>
<p>Numeracy</p>		<p>Go on a pattern hunt around your house. Take photos or draw pictures of the patterns you find.</p>	<p>Practise your addition within 10, 20, 100 using 'Topmarks' online.</p>	<p>Go on a shape hunt around your house or in your garden/outdoors. How many different shapes can you find? Can you name them?</p>
<p>STEAM (science, art, technology)</p>		<p>Make a model of an alien using recyclable materials in your house. Check your plastic and paper bins!</p>	<p>Practise using patterns in transient art. Go outside, can you use leaves, sticks, stones etc to create patterns?</p>	<p>With an adults help, use 'art hub for kids' on YouTube 'how to draw an alien' to draw an alien of your choice. You can pause the video at different stages so that you can follow the instructions carefully.</p>
<p>ICT</p>		<p>Play 'Obb and Bob' on the Letters and Sounds Website.</p>	<p>Practise typing your sounds on the computer. Practise typing words from a book on the computer.</p>	<p>Use a paint app on the computer/laptop/ipad/phone to create a picture of your family! This will help to build your concentration and fine motor skills.</p>
<p>Health & Wellbeing</p>		<p>Go on a nature walk. Collect pine cones, leaves, acorns, stones, shells etc to share in class.</p>	<p>Learn to tie your shoe laces with help from an adult or older sibling.</p>	<p>Go on a walk around your community. What can you see? Photograph any shops, parks, bus stops etc and we can talk about these in class.</p>
