


## Thursday 28th May 2020

Happy Thursday! We are almost at the end of the week and one day closer to a bank holiday long weekend. Below are today's Literacy and Numeracy tasks.

## **Numeracy**

Today we will continue to learn about tally marks. Remember that when we record or count tally marks, we count four lines down and the fifth line we 'karate chop' through the four lines. This is why it is good practise to count in 5's.



There will be two tally mark tasks on See-Saw for you today.

For the first task, you should count the tally marks and tell me how many there are. Remember for each complete 'tally' there are 5, so you need to count in 5s. If you get to an incomplete one, you would stop at the number you got to and begin to count in 1s.

For the second task, you will record how many of each fruit there are and record this with tally marks. You can then create a pictogram of each fruit. This means if there are 5 bananas, you would draw 5 bananas into the chart.





Today for Literacy we are learning about antonyms. These are words that mean the opposite. For example, the antonym for 'top' would be 'bottom'. Can you write in your jotter what the antonyms would be for the following words?
