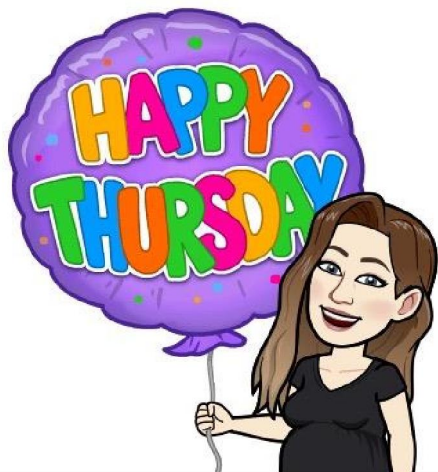

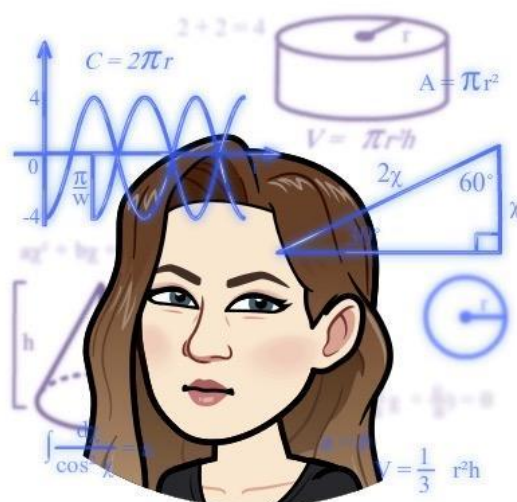

Today we will be focussing on Phonics for our Literacy work, and Data Handling for Numeracy. I hope you enjoy the tasks 😊

Numeracy

For your Numeracy task today we will be looking at Data Handling again. We have been learning how to draw bar charts, and today to finish this off I'd like you to conduct your own piece of research and create your own bar chart from this!

1. Choose 4 of your toys.
2. Ask as many friends and family members as possible (the more the better) which their favourite is. As they tell you, you could record their answer with a tally mark.
3. Total up how many votes each toy received and create a bar chart with this information. There will a template on See-Saw you can use by drawing onto on See-Saw, or you can print it off and do it on paper.



Literacy



You are going to start off by reading your own comics! Below is a website with comics that have decodable words allowing children to read these independently. Generally, Primary 1's will be able to read up to Phase 4 and Primary 2's Phase 5a, however please use your own judgement of what feels right for you and move

back/forward depending on how easy or difficult you find it.
