Pupils who use the Central Groups Transport Association buses to rehearsals will be picked up at their usual pick-up point but **one hour earlier than normal except the Kinross bus on Wednesday 27 March which will be picking up 45mins earlier than usual.** Please see transport timetable included in this letter.
