HEAD TEACHER UPDATE

It has been a lively start to session 2022-23 at Eastbank Academy. As the fourth week of term draws to a close, I write with some useful updates on life at our school.

1. New First Year

Our S1 pupils have settled in incredibly well and have made a great start to life at Eastbank Academy. All S1 pupils should remain in the school grounds at lunchtime – we will review this arrangement in due course. There will be an S1 parents' evening on Wednesday 12 October and I look forward to meeting everybody then.

2. Time-keeping

A small number of young people are continuing to arrive late for school in the morning. I know from personal experience the challenges that families can face in the morning. However, it is important that young people arrive at school in good time, and are ready to move to class when the bell rings. Late arrival, even of a few minutes, results in lost learning and disrupts the flow of lessons. We are continuing to run reflection sessions at lunchtime for those pupils who arrive late. Please support us by ensuring your sons/daughters arrive on time for school.

3. Christmas Fayre

We are excited to be holding a Christmas Fayre on 12 November this year. S2 and S3 will receive their first report shortly after the October holiday.
