Please use the guided reading cards in the activities section.</p> <p>Jolly Phonic Sounds In the activities section we have uploaded Jollyphonics flash cards. Please show them to your child and practice their recognition of the sounds. Make sure that they are saying the 'pure' sound and not adding any letters. For example 't' not 'ti'.</p> <p>Writing Dictation practice using word box words you have been practicing (or you could start with word box 1 and move through the scheme) read the word out to your child and ask them to write it down. Imaginative writing If you could be a dinosaur for a day, which one would you be and why? What would you do and where would you go? Try to write a few sentences and you could draw a picture of you as a dinosaur too! Remember to use capital letters, a full stop and finger spaces. Your child may be able to write words and sentences independently or they may need more help to come up with ideas and to copy words.
