









CASH FOR KIDS FOR KIRKLANDNEUK

We have been nominated for a **Cash for Kids** fundraiser!

Kirklandneuk has been selected from hundreds of schools to be

one of **20** schools to compete in this year's schools challenge. In order to compete in the challenge, the chosen schools are tasked with attempting to raise **£1,500+** in three weeks. If we raise over £1500 by 31 March 2022, we then have a very good chance of winning the following prizes:

- 1st prize £3000
- 2nd prize **£2000**
- 3rd prize **£1000**
- 6 x prizes of £250

So, out of the 20 schools, we are in with a fairly good chance of adding to any fundraising that we manage to raise!

All money raised needs to go through the Clyde 1 Cash for Kids Just Giving Page and every penny raised for Kirklandneuk will come back to Kirklandneuk Primary School (even if we don't raise £1500). PLUS – if our supporters tick the gift aid box, they will automatically gift this part to Cash for Kids!

Our PTA and Parent Council have helped us to organise the following in-school fundraisers which will all go towards the Cash for Kids competition, giving us a really good chance of winning even more money for our school:

- > w/c 14 March: Guess the Bunny's Birthday (50p per go) and Guess How Many Sweeties are in the Jar (20p per go) (Chuck-it-in-the-bucket cash donations)
- > <u>w/c 21 March:</u> Sponsored Skip see how long we can skip for! (Chuck-it-in-the-bucket cash donation or discretionary online donation)
- w/c 28 March: Easter / Spring Fun Day & Egg Hunt (Chuck-it-in-the-bucket cash donation or discretionary online donation)
