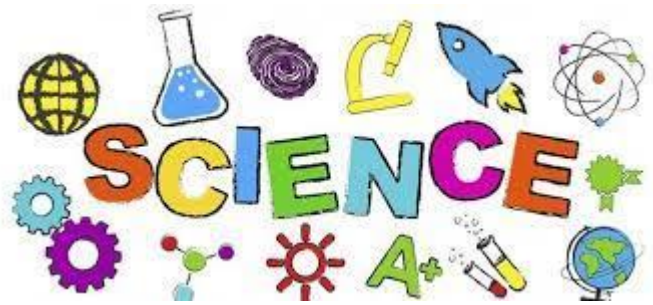
SCHOOL MEALS UPDATE – EASTER TREATS
