<p><b>Literacy &amp; art</b> Before we leave you will need to pack your suitcase and bring your passport. Using the templates provided in the <b>activities section</b> draw pictures of what you will be taking with you or write a few sentences. Think carefully about what you will need – what clothes will you bring, suncream, teddy bear, money, etc.</p> <p>Design your passport also to make sure you can board the plane – remember to include your name and age and a picture of yourself.</p> <p>Watch the Monsters Inc ride clip. It is a 360 degree experience so you can drag the screen all around you to see. Design your own monster and use adjectives to describe them. Are they kind, scary, fluffy, angry? Would you like to live under the sea?</p>	<p><b>Numeracy</b> During the plane trip, take a look at the map of Disneyland in the <b>activities section</b> and see if you can find your way through it. Can you start at the entrance and go to Donald Duck's house boat? Can you start at the log flume and go to the rollercoaster? Can you start at the pond and go the Frozen ride? Talk with your adult about what attractions you have to go past and use left and right if you can when giving directions.</p> <p>Using the snack menu for the café in Disneyland in the <b>activities section</b>, circle the snack that you would like and choose the correct coins to pay for it. You could challenge yourself by working out much change would you get if you paid with a 10p coin?</p> <p>Mickey has set you a challenge to record the times on the clock for various activities you will be doing. Using the template in the <b>activities section</b>, see if you can record the times accurately.</p>
<p><b>Health and Wellbeing</b> Safety Rules Look at the video of Disneyland in the link below. Can you think of any rules or things that you would need to do to keep safe at the park? You could use sticks, blocks, or anything else that you wish. Be as creative as you can!</p> <p>Look at this picture from the movie 'Moana' in the <b>activities section</b>. Only 1 in 1000 turtles live to be adults, they need our help! Can you help the baby turtle to get to the sea by pointing out all of the obstacles. What do humans need to do when they are on the beach to keep turtles safe?</p>
