S4-6 Pupils (2 allocated)</u></p> <p>The Young Ambassador Programme is a key element of sport Scotland’s contribution to developing young people as leaders in sport. The programme gives school-based young people aged 14-17 the opportunity to motivate and inspire other young people to participate in sport. The Young Ambassadors programme is run by sport Scotland and funded through the National Lottery.</p> <p><u>The Role of the Young Ambassador</u></p> <p>At the heart of the Young Ambassador programme is the principle that their views, and those of other young people are heard, valued and influence decision making; and that they are engaged in driving change. The key role of the Young Ambassador is to motivate and inspire other young people to participate in sport and physical activity. This involves inspiring pupils aged 5-18 to participate in PE, school sport, extracurricular activities, and local activity clubs. Young Ambassadors have a pivotal role within their school and wider community; they are advocates, role models and leaders of other young people.</p> <p>Young Ambassadors will be supported by their Active Schools and Community Sport Officer and their secondary school to achieve the aims below.
