Young Drivers Day – 18th June 2024

This one-day event is open to all current S6 pupils. Current S5 pupils may also apply and will be allocated a place if numbers allow.

For the morning sessions pupils will work in groups with representatives from Road Policing and the Scottish Fire Service on topics including:

Construction and Use – PC Rowan (Roads Policing)

Road Traffic Law (drink/drug driving, ASB, etc.) – PC Costley (Roads Policing)

VR Presentation – Tony Reid (SFRS)

Vulnerable Road Users Input – PC Martin (YEO)

In the afternoon, the Scottish Fire Service will demonstrate a crashed vehicle scenario to the whole year group. We will then watch a video presentation from the Roads Policing Unit, before a short debrief at the end of the day.
