### Record Breaking Evening

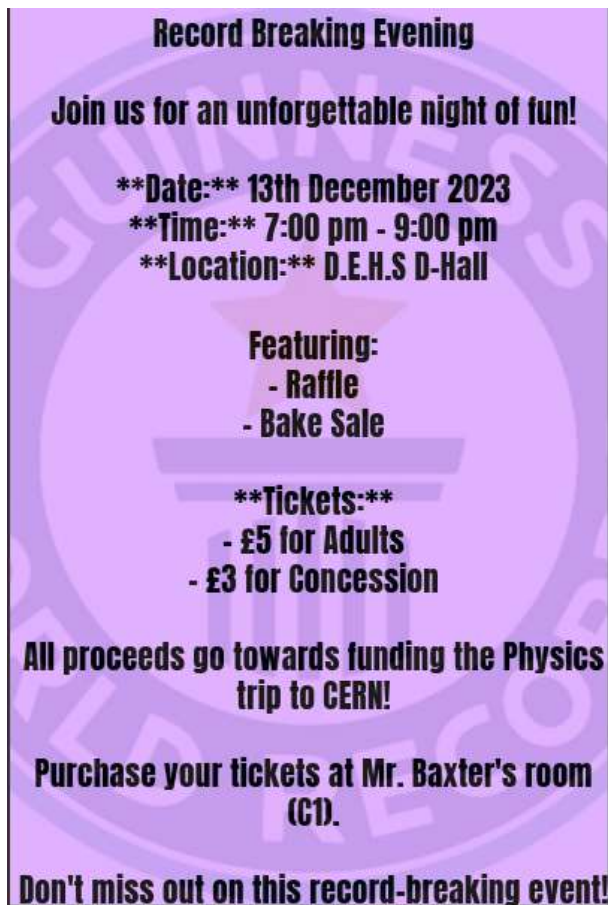
The AH & Higher physics pupils are going for gold!
