	Dumfries and Galloway Regional Youth Choir – Summer Term 2024		
	The Choir has been going now for nearly 20 years and is open to anyone from current S2 (rising S3) to S6 who enjoys singing. We know that a lot of people are not necessarily used to singing in Choirs these days and may have a very firm opinion that it is 'not for them'. We try to change this view and had a great year of singing in 2023, including a memorable residential trip in the Peak District.		

The music that we sing covers a wide selection of musical styles, ranging from Musical Theatre, Pop, Classical and Jazz, as well as music from Scotland and further afield. You do not have to audition – everyone is welcome and it is absolutely free.

Rehearsals will take place in Minerva Hall, Dumfries Academy on Sunday 2<sup>nd</sup> June (10am-4pm) and 16<sup>th</sup> June (10am-1pm) with the afternoon rehearsal that day (2pm-4.30pm) taking place at St John's Church, Lovers' Walk, Dumfries, where we then give a free Concert at 6pm.

Transport is provided within our limited means, with a mini bus leaving from both Annan Academy and Kirkcudbright Academy (via Castle Douglas). Please indicate on the form if you wish to make use of this. Please also note that transport is NOT provided after the Concert on 16<sup>th</sup> June.

We have an active twinning link with the Choir of the Humboldt Gymnasium, Germany and regularly have residential rehearsals and events in both the UK and abroad. We are due to go on the return leg of our current twinning project which will see the choir travel to Germany for a week of joint singing, concerts and visits between 14<sup>th</sup> and 21<sup>st</sup> December 2024.

We will be looking for expressions of interest for this during the rehearsals above and I will provide further details in due course.
