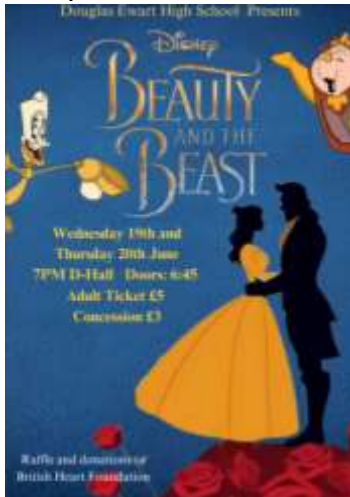
## School Show

## Laptops- A12

Pupils are reminded that the laptops which can usually be found in A12 must only be used in the middle corridor in the A block- ie the English, Media and Modern Language classrooms.
