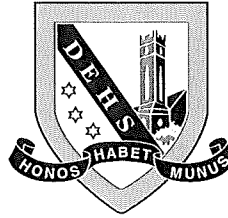

Uniform Code & How to Place an Order

Black sweatshirts, black hoodies and polo shirts (white S1-S4, black S5-S6), all with the school logo, are available for parents/carers to order from website: www.stevensons.co.uk

For a limited period, Stevensons are offering free delivery to the school if parents/carers place their orders **by Tuesday 6th February 2024**. Please ensure you select delivery to the school option when ordering. Orders placed by this date will be delivered to the school during week commencing 26th February. After 6th February, if you order any of these uniform items from Stevensons, then you will be charged postage. Stevensons will offer another date during this school session where free delivery to the school is an option for a set period and we will notify you of this in due course.

The uniform code is as follows for the Douglas-Ewart High School:

S1-S4

Black trousers/black skirt/plain black leggings (no sports' leggings)/plain black shorts of reasonable length

White shirt

White polo shirt with school logo - pupils do not need to wear a tie with the polo shirt

School tie

Black sweatshirt with school logo/black hoodie with school logo

Plain black jumper - minimal branding - small logo on arm or left/right of chest - no branding across the chest

Plain black belt

Plain socks/tights - flesh, white, black or grey

Footwear that is sensible - black shoes, black trainers, black Converse

Limited jewellery

Limited makeup

S5 - S6/

S5-S6

Black trousers/black skirt/plain black leggings (no sports' leggings)/plain black shorts of reasonable length

Black shirt

Black polo shirt with school logo - pupils do not need to wear a tie with the polo shirt

School tie

Black sweatshirt with school logo/black hoodie with school logo

Plain black jumper - minimal branding - small logo on arm or left/right of chest - no branding across the chest

Plain black belt

Plain socks/tights - flesh, white, black or grey

Non-compliance with Uniform Code

On the first occasion, the pupil will be spoken to and a message shared with parent/carer via *Groupcall*.

On the second occasion within a term, parents/carers will be contacted via phone with a view to investigating any difficulties or challenges preventing their child from following the uniform code. A meeting will be held between the young person and the support team.

On the third occasion within a term, parents/carers will be asked to join a meeting with the school to discuss ways in which we can work together to ensure their young person follows the dress code.

We hope to build on our positive relationships. However, persistent non-compliance could constitute a challenge to the authority of the Acting Head Teacher and could lead to disciplinary action. This action may include, although not exclusively, removal of social time privileges or extra-curricular privileges until a resolution is reached. If safe to do so and with parental support, a member of the Senior Management Team may instruct the young person to return home and change.
