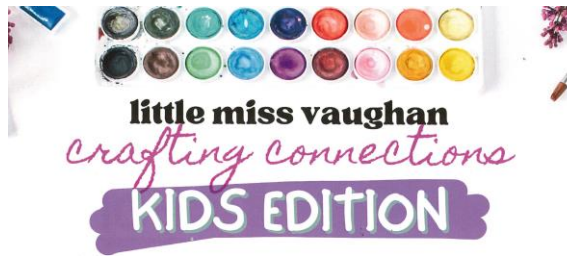

Laptops- A12

Pupils are reminded that the laptops which can usually be found in A12 must only be used in the middle corridor in the A block- i.e. the English, Media and Modern Language classrooms.

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<p>You can usually collect them from A12 at the start of the period or when granted permission by your teacher. You are very welcome in A12 but please try to remember that any pupils in the class are learning.
