In honour of the 70th anniversary of Roger Bannister breaking the four-minute mile on 6 May 1954, this year's challenge is to **'Run the World'** one mile at a time. The Douglas High School has signed up!

Staff and pupils are invited to run 8 laps (1 mile) of the Athletics track on **Tuesday 7 May 2024** during **periods 3 and 4**. Pupils who wish to take part, should express their interest to their P3 class teacher and if this is suitable should make their way to the PE department after registration. There is no requirement for pupils to change however the changing rooms will be available for those who would prefer to complete their mile in their running/PE kit. The total number of miles completed by pupils (and staff) will be registered on the World Mile Challenge App – there will be a 'total miles run' calculator clocking all mile registered so that all participants can track their collective progress.

(We will not be taking any individual timings, participants are welcome to record their own time using their own electronic device, and there are no individual placings – this is a **whole school effort**).
