<p>In the afternoon, the Scottish Fire Service will demonstrate a crashed vehicle scenario to the whole year group. We will then watch a video presentation from the Roads Policing Unit, before a short debrief at the end of the day.</p> <p>I would recommend that all S6 pupils attend this one-day course, even if you are not yet thinking about learning to drive.</p> <p>To sign up, please collect a consent for from the School Office.</p>
