## It is important that

- We speak to each other the way we want to be spoken to ourselves
- "We treat everyone with courtesy, consideration and respect
- We accept each other's differences and diversity without exception
- "We use mobile 'phones and social networking sites appropriately
- We keep our hands and feet to ourselves
- We are responsible and encourage the reporting of bullying

## Action that will be taken if bullying is reported

- Interviews will be carried out with all involved
- Information will be gathered
- Appropriate action will be decided upon
- Parents will be informed
- "We will enable everyone affected by an incident to play a part in repairing the harm and so to find a positive way forward.
