Changes to Early Learning and Childcare Provision—1140 hours

You are likely aware that the number of funded hours for early learning and childcare will increase from 640 hours to 1140 hours form August 2020. The applications process for early learning and childcare

(ELC) places in Perth & Kinross Council nursery classes and early childhood centres is changing, from January 2020. With a huge increase in funded (free) ELC provision for 3-5 year olds and eligible 2 year olds, we're looking to make applying for a place for your child as simple and straightforward as possible. From 20 January 2020, you will be able to apply online via the Council website. Look out for full details coming in the New Year. ATTENDANCE

Perth & Kinross Council is committed to improving the life chances of all school pupils and to working in partnership with parents to enable their children to achieve success at school and in their future lives. We have a shared duty of care and commitment to keep our children and young people safe, secure and healthy. It is a parent's legal duty to provide an efficient education, suitable to age, ability and aptitude either by sending the child to school or by other means. If your child attends school, it is an offence for him/her to be absent without reasonable excuse.

At Our Lady's we want to work with parents/carers to improve pupils' attendance and lateness at school. There are many reasons why children and young people do not attend school, but SCHOOL DAY we are committed to finding solutions to any barriers. We closely monitor attendance and lateness of all children to ensure they have the best opportunity to learn and succeed for their future. Children who currently have an attendance rate of less than 92% or a significant



number of lates will receive a letter early next term alerting their parent/carer and inviting you to discuss solutions to improve attendance. Perth & Kinross Council have an attendance target rate of 96%.

P1 REGISTRATION

If your child will be five before the last day of February 2021, then it will soon be time to enrol them for school.

If your child will be five on or before that date, you should register your child to start school during the January registration week, which in 2020 will be week commencing 13 January 2020.

If your child is five between 19 August 2020 and 28 February 2021 they are eligible to start school on Wednesday 19 August 2020 and you should register your child for primary school during the January 2020 registration week. However, nearer to the start of the school year you may wish to delay your child's entry to school if you think that they are not ready to start.
