HUB REFURB UPDATE



Exciting times ahead as works continue to progress steadily with Letham4All Community Hub

After the building works are completed the Letham Community Hub will have a ground floor community gym, an improved sports hall, community kitchen and soft play area, multi-purpose rooms and space for a range of health and wellbeing activities. The changing village will also have disabled facilities that meet the Changing Place Standard and lift to the upper floor, making the whole building accessible.

We will be changing the entrance to the building so the front door will face the Rannoch Road Park, and there will be small car park, complete with an electric vehicle charging point and disabled carparking spaces and a bike park.

There will also be extensive improvement works happening at the same time to the Rannoch Road Park. The existing hard surface basketball court will be moved further down the park and the children play equipment will be renewed and moved nearer to new building. We are hoping for the grand opening to be around end of November 2022.

While our works in the HUB are being completed our groups are being held in different locations temporarily in our community.

TOOT, TOOT GREAT NEWS



Letham4All are celebrating the purchase of a minibus to support their work in the community. A massive thanks to the Robertson Trust and the Guildry Incorporation of Perth who supported the purchase of the bus, along with money raised by ourselves. We just couldn't have done this without them. We also need to say many thanks to Derrick Allan for his generous donation and also to Tay Graphix who kindly made such a great job of putting the logo's on the bus. The 17-seater bus is fully accessible, with a wheelchair lift fitted as it can be reconfigured to be wheelchair accessible.

We really do want this to be a Community Minibus and we are offering the use of the vehicle to other local organisations to help them enhance their work. Accessing transport can be difficult and expensive, so we hope that the bus will be of real benefit to the community. We are putting a big shout out to anyone who has the category of D1 on their driving license who wants to get involved and become a volunteer driver to please get in touch.

Volunteer and Board Member Stuart Kerr who will be managing the minibus advised that there will be a couple of formalities that groups and drivers will need to agree to before using the bus, but it is straightforward. Volunteer drivers need to agree to have a license check and will have to take part in a vehicle familiarisation session before they take the bus out for the first time.

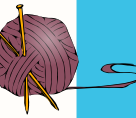

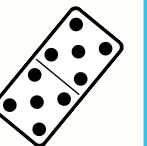

COMMUNITY FOOD SHARE zero waste

The Community Fridge4All was the first of its kind in Perth and has been set up with support from Zero Waste. The team at Letham4All support other communities in Perth to run their own community food shares, distributing surplus food amongst all of the local projects.

You will find Letham community fridge at 119 Rannoch Road, Letham, located in the Community Learning and Development Building.

These are sorted by volunteers and are available as "swaps" or for a small donation in the SWAP SHOP .A large store of household goods and bedding, which is in good re-usable condition, is also put aside so that families or individuals can be encouraged to consider re-using these items which would otherwise go to landfill. These items are also available to agencies working with families moving into emergency accommodation or a new tenancy.
