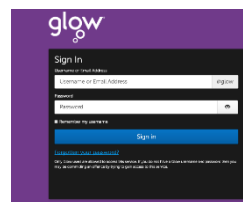
SeeSaw

Most classes will issue work via SeeSaw, in order to be able to access and complete activities, parents will need to download the SeeSaw Class App. All teachers will give learners a new 'Home Learning' QR code which they will use to sign into their individual SeeSaw account. Step by step instructions accompany the new QR code. Learners will sign in at home the same way they do in class.



Glow

Some classes (P3a, P3b, P3/4, P6a & P6b) will also issue work via Glow, in particular Google Classroom. All learners have been issued with Glow log in details and passwords. If teachers are choosing to use Glow they will have spent some time taking learners through how to use Glow and where to find their work.
