WHAT HAPPENS WHEN HEAVY SNOW FALLS DURING THE DAY?

- Where possible we shall try to remain open and provide normal teaching. However, if conditions worsen, it may be necessary to close during the day.
- Should this situation arise an email will be sent to parents. SEESAW will also be updated.
- If we have to close children will not be permitted to leave school without firstly contacting parents to ensure each child is returned to a responsible adult.
- If school bus and taxi providers make a decision to collect children early parents will be informed by the school.
- In the situation that some staff members could be sent home classes may be rearranged.
