



### **Promoting British Values**

At Low Hill Nursery we promote British Values.

Our aim is that young people leave school prepared for life in modern Britain. We believe it is our duty to actively promote the fundamental British Values of democracy, the rule of law, and individual liberty. We also value the need for mutual respect and tolerance of the different faiths and beliefs of others.

At the nursery our aim is that children will have a developing understanding of:

- how decisions are made and have a part in making decisions in our setting by encouraging children to have a voice and to listen to others
- the freedom to have faith and beliefs that may be the same or different to other people and these will not be the cause of prejudicial or discriminatory behaviour
- identifying and combating discrimination amongst their peers and the wider community

As part of our curriculum, all children and their families are welcomed to join us in celebrating a range of traditions from a variety of cultures and faiths. These include: Chinese New Year, Christmas, Diwali, Eid and Easter.

Children are always encouraged to talk about their families and share objects from home. Photographs of children's families are displayed in Family groups in the nursery.

Objects that reflect home life are used in the nursery by adults and children especially in the home corner and role play areas to promote cultural acceptance.

We actively offer children the opportunity to prepare and eat healthy snacks from around the world.

Parents are encouraged to share their views, ideas and expertise. We have a complaints policy for parents, visitors. Governors and staff to access.

We adhere to Equality Duty 2010 and we have a promoting positive behaviour and anti-bullying policy.
