Curriculum Areas

Literacy

- I will be able to use phonemes to support me in reading and spelling vocabulary I need
- I will be able to use picture clues and key vocabulary to support me in identifying the meaning of texts
- I will be able to use punctuation marks within my own independent writing
- I will be able to listen to stories and recall important events and vocabulary
- I will be able to write a list of instructions
- I will be able to vary sentences openers in my writing
