#### Term 2

##### Literacy

- Continue to apply my knowledge of phonemes when reading, writing and spelling.
- Begin to develop an understanding of spelling rules
- Read with independence and be able to find key information to answer a variety of questions or share knowledge.
- Develop skills in writing for a variety of purposes, including letter writing, poetry and advertising
- Develop skill in editing work.

##### Numeracy and Mathematics

- Continue to develop skills in adding and subtracting using column methods
- Know that symbols can represent unknown numbers
- Further develop my knowledge of fractions to be able to talk about fractions equal to 1 and find and show simple fractions of shapes.
- To be able to find fractions of amounts by sharing and then counting.
- Be able to add and subtract fractions with the same denominators.

- Participate in social dance, developing skills in remembering the sequence of steps and moving in time to the music.
