Learning Intentions

Literacy

Learning Context: Our local area/mapping

We will be learning to:

- include relevant ideas, knowledge and information in a text
- use an appropriate style and format to convey information
- recognise and use language to persuade the reader
- use our own words to make and organise notes, selecting key information to create a new text
- plan and deliver a promotional video with relevant content and appropriate structure
- demonstrate our understanding of a text by answering a range of questions
- consistently apply basic punctuation to written texts
- understand the effect of, and apply, more complex punctuation in written texts

Numeracy and Maths

We will be learning to:

- develop our mental and written strategies to solve calculations with a variety of numbers including decimals and large numbers
- develop our speed of recall of the times tables
- use knowledge of grid references and coordinates to draw shapes from given coordinates and translate (move) shapes up the y axis or along the x axis
- Apply problem solving and multiplication skills to calculate area and perimeter of shapes
