As an accredited Reading School, we are committed to encouraging our learners to become life-long readers and promote reading for pleasure on a daily basis. To celebrate this event we will be engaging in various additional reading activities throughout the week in both our ELC and school classes.

On Thursday 3rd March 2022, we will have some whole school celebration activities throughout the day including:

- A dress down day for all in both ELC and school. ELC children can come to school in their pyjamas if they wish to do so.
