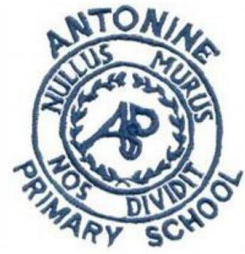

Dear Parents/Carers

Today your child will come home with a paper copy of their home learning grid and associated worksheets. This will be the last day that this will happen. All pupils are working on Microsoft Teams to share learning. If you cannot access Microsoft Teams please contact us to help you. In most cases we have supported so far it has been something very simple. The best way to access Teams is to download the Teams app or sign into glow and use the Microsoft button there. Pupils do not need a device or phone to work on. Jotters have been provided for them to record their work. You only need to be able to read the online tasks.

We have added a Supporting Learning at Home area to the Resources page on our website. Advice on accessing Teams can be found there.

As part of supporting learning both in school and at home, we will be uploading materials for you to access should your child have to self-isolate at home. These are to support the homework that is already being posted. One of the overviews available will be from the website BBC Bitesize. Each stage has a literacy and numeracy overview which will show the type of learning that should be taking place. BBC Bitesize have videos and tasks linked to these learning areas. It's a very easy website to use and will support home learning for pupils with tasks that are age appropriate.

Over the next few weeks we are developing stage appropriate learning grids which will offer yet another source of activities for pupils should they be working from home.

In the event that whole classes or the school needs to self-isolate teachers will be posting teaching lessons by video onto Teams for pupils to watch.

The school is working well and safety measures are in place. We are planning for every eventuality and want to ensure that all pupils have access to these materials.
