<u>Suspected COVID-19 Flowchart for Families</u> <u>August 2020</u>



The flowchart below will help you make the decision whether to send your child/ren to ELCC/school in relation to COVID-19 symptoms.

Everyone in your household wakes up in the morning feeling fine and symptom free.



Attend Antonine as normal.

If anyone in your household wakes up in the morning with symptoms consistent with COVID-19.

(Please see below)

DO NOT attend Antonine. (including siblings)

Contact the school office to let them know that your child/ren will not be in.

If a child or adult displays any of the following symptoms it will be treated as possible COVID-19 case:

- A high temperature or fever
- A new, continuous cough*
- A loss of, or change in sense of smell or taste

*A new continuous cough is where you:

- have a new cough that has lasted for an hour
- have had 3 or more episodes of coughing in 24 hours
- are coughing more than usual

<u>OR</u> if you have returned (or come) to Scotland from a country which is not exempt from the Scottish Government quarantine rules, you should stay at home and follow the relevant guidance. Please see

Other members of the household to self-isolate for 14 days
