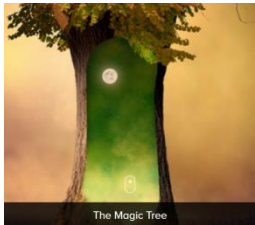
GLOW Access – Signing in to glow allows pupils to access a range of different sites for learning as well as access to the class TEAMS page which will have homework grids and worksheets.

Each day there is a different picture for you to talk about with your child. With the picture, comes a drawing task, questions for your child to think about. They may answer them orally or by writing the answer. This will depend on the level that your child is working at.

Keep your child up to date with what is happening in the world. Newsround is updated daily with current affairs written for children. There is a mixture of articles to read and ones to listen to. There are quizzes and games that have an educational value to them too.

Get epic is an online library of around 35,000 quality books. There are fiction books as well as non-fiction, comic strips and videos. There are also quizzes to accompany the stories.



[BBC Bitesized Spelling and Grammar](#) – P5 to S3

This contains entertaining video clips, word lists and teaching to help children understand when to use different spellings.

It is useful, to ask you child to also write down the words as they are more likely to be remembered and spelled correctly if they are handwritten.


There aren't any tasks for them to do, but they will help to reinforce spelling patterns, grammar and punctuation.

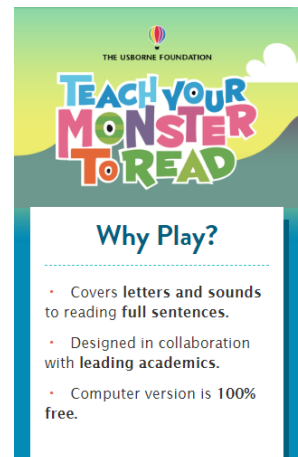
For many parents, this will be a blast from the past. It is dated and the video quality is not as good as modern programs, but the stories are still captivating.

A kid-safe, ad-free streaming library of read-aloud animated storybooks.

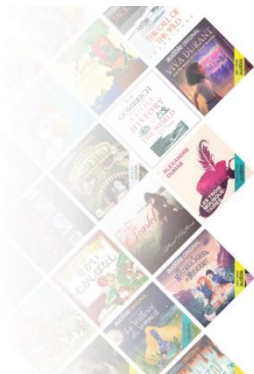
