2. Apologies	<p>There were apologies received from Julie Chambers and Kathleen McNiven.</p>	
3. Election of Office Bearers	<p>Caitlen Flood elected as Secretary. Karianne Bruning elected as Treasurer. SBW, GB, LS remain in positions.</p>	
4. Head Teacher's Report	<p>Mrs McLaughlin had shared documents including the Standards & Quality report for 2020-21.</p> <p>There is a good buzz in school, children are happy. Big focus on nurture and friendships. Staff are attending Place2Be training in relation to mental health.</p> <p>Council of the Future is the scheme providing a device to all P6 and P7s – these will be issued in November. Additional ipads will be issued to schools for P1-P5 pupil use.</p> <p>The Breakfast Club is not funded through PEF funding; it is run by Falkirk Council. It will continue at 8.30am start.</p>	

	<p>Re COVID, numbers are being reported to Falkirk Council. Several viral bugs going around currently – families should continue to follow guidance.</p> <p>All staff have been vaccinated.</p> <p>CEM Assessments have been done with children P2 upwards. These provide good data and insight in the level the children are working at.</p> <p>St Joseph’s Primary have experienced some vandalism in their playground – their nursery shed was destroyed and lots of litter and glass in the playground. Mrs McLaughlin asked community to be vigilant and support our neighbours.</p> <p>All staff are attending Talk4Reading training with school focus on reading.</p> <p>Children will also be Learning for Sustainability – a Falkirk wide initiative.</p> <p>Miss Ross will return from maternity leave in November.</p> <p>Parents Night will be online and phone calls. If video call doesn’t work, teachers will call.</p>
