Numeracy and Mathematics

We will be working on the following topics in Numeracy, which are differentiated:

'Less than' and 'more than', introduction to algebra and ideas of chance and uncertainty.

Pupils will be focussing on **symmetry and data handling** as their maths topics. We will be using active strategies to support pupils' learning: Numicon, ICT, manipulatives, number lines and number squares.

Health and Wellbeing

Mind-set Mantras: "Feedback is a gift – Accept it!" and "A goal without a plan is just a wish." We will use 'emotion works' check-ins daily to express how we are feeling and what we can do to manage our emotions.

We will be working through the "healthy schools" programme.

P.E – Outdoor P.E will take place on a **Thursday**. Our learning will focus on Athletics and hockey. Indoor PE will take place on a **Wednesday** and will focus on gymnastics.
