

## Numeracy and Mathematics

We will be working on the following topics in Numeracy, which will be differentiated:

- Place value - pupils will explore numbers to 100/1000. They will learn the number before, between or after any given number to 100/1000. They will also cover counting in 2s, 3s, 4s, 5s and 10s. Pupils will also sequence a set of numbers within 100/1000, starting with either the largest or smallest number.
- Addition - Pupils will be working on addition to 20/100 this term. We will explore the column method in numeracy when adding 2-digit numbers.

We will use active strategies to support their learning: Numicon, ICT, Concrete materials, Number lines and squares.

## Learning Across the Curriculum

### ICT

Pupils will practise logging on to the computer, mouse control and basic keyboard skills. We will be learning to use shortcuts with the keyboard.

## Literacy

Pupils will be developing and enhancing:

- Phonemes and spelling - These will be developed through using a variety of active spelling strategies.
- Reading - The pupils will continue the reading programme in accordance with their book band.
- Writing - The pupils will be creating letters, imaginative story writing, personal writing and poetry.
- Handwriting - Pupils will work on joining their phonemes weekly and be expected to transfer this into their daily written work.

## Class Novel

This term we will read Charlie and the Chocolate Factory. We will be discussing the main events that happen in the novel, as well as looking at the plot, characters and setting.

## Science

### Major Organs, Skeleton and the Five Senses

Our topic this term will be Major Organs, the Skeleton and our Five Senses.

- We will explore each sense in depth, identifying how important our senses are in our environment.
- We will research about Louis Braille and look at the braille alphabet, linking to sight.
- We will identify some of the major organs in the body looking at their functions and positions.
- We will carry out interesting experiments and research using books and technology.
