You should send:

- ✓ your name and class
- ✓ the name of the place that you rated
- ✓ your score out of 10
- ✓ a photo of your design idea to make the place even better
(Please note we ask that **children's faces do not** appear in the photo)

5. Completed challenges will be shared with ROMPS House Captains who will award house points at the House Day at the end of March.

6. Look out for completed challenges on the school Twitter page throughout the month and then the total house points awarded at the end of the challenge.
