

Numeracy and Maths

We will be working on the following topics in Numeracy which will be differentiated:

- Pupils will be working on the concept of Multiplication. We will explore the following strategies to support our understanding, equal groups, arrays and repeated addition.
- Pupils will find $\frac{1}{2}$ s, $\frac{1}{4}$ s and $\frac{1}{3}$ s of shapes and numbers. We will use concrete materials and technology to support our understanding.
- Pupils will be working with money; they will identify coins up to a value of £1 and work out giving change making link to subtraction facts.

We will use active strategies to support their learning: Numicon, ICT, Concrete materials, Number lines and technology.

Scottish Inventors
