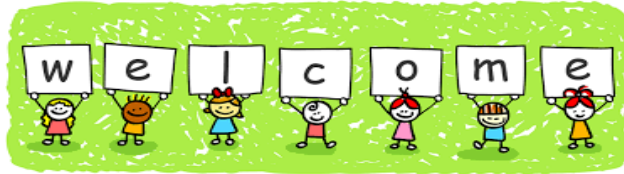




Robert Owen Memorial Primary School Early Learning and Childcare Newsletter September 2021
