As I have previously shared, unfortunately due to Covid-19 we are currently unable to welcome our Primary 7 families and pupils physically into the school building for transition activities. We will continue to take advice from Fife Council Education and Children's Services and Public Health on a regular basis and if anything changes we will keep you updated.

I will continue to work with primary colleagues on a number of plans so that should anything change we will be ready. We understand the cancellation of transition visits is disappointing but we have to work within all current guidelines and as a school we always put safety first.

In the meantime all information will be shared via Sways, videos and potentially more Teams meetings. I will utilise the information collated from the pupil and parent 'What Matters to Me' surveys to ensure that key concerns, queries and topics are being addressed.
