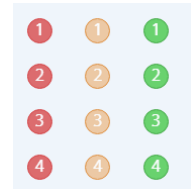


## Understanding your child's levels on Didbook



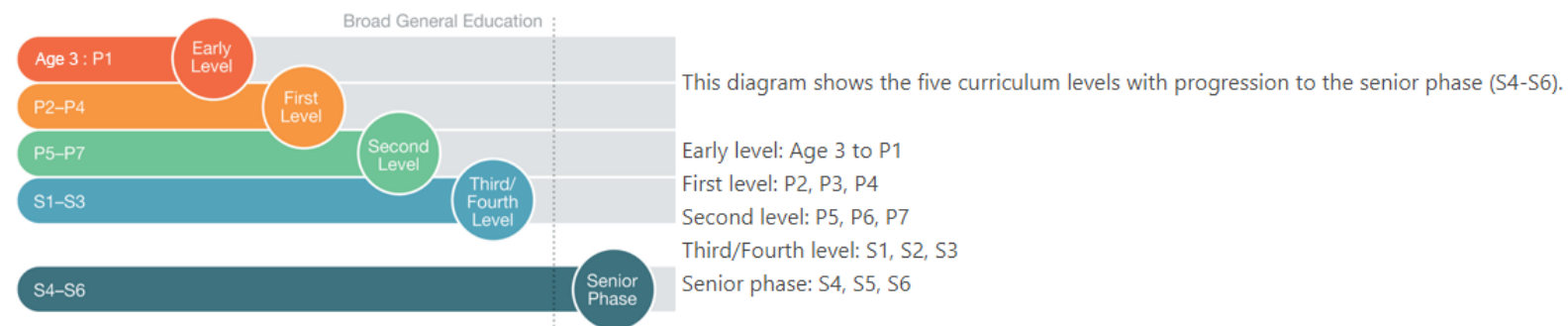
When looking at your child's progress on Didbook (Progress), you will see a coloured circle with a number within it for each subject area, as indicated below.

The information below should help you to understand what the colours and numbers mean but please do not hesitate to get in touch if you need anything else.



The diagram below shows the different levels students work within at school, with the year groups being a guide as to when most young people will be secure in that level.

There are five curriculum levels - Early, First, Second, Third and Fourth - in the **broad general education** (from early years to the end of S3).



The number in the coloured circle refers to **the level they are currently working within.**

The colour in the circle refers to **how much progress they are making within that level**

**Red** would indicate that they are only just starting to work within that level.

**Amber** would indicate that they are working within that level on most occasions.

**Green** would indicate that they are always working within that level and should be aiming to move to the next level.

As the year progresses, additional judgements will be entered and a selection of these will provide specific points for your child to work on in each of the subject areas. These points for improvement will be discussed in class but we would appreciate your support by discussing progress with your child.
