

Reminder for Pupils Returning to School this week.

We are looking forward to welcoming all our pupils into school this week, below are a few points we would like to remind pupils and parents about so they are prepared for their return to school. - All parents should use the pupil drop off point, located at the front of the school just past the public bus stop (just before the turn into Ormiston Drive). There are limited spaces so please allow time when planning your journey.
- All pupils will be required to sanitise their hands before they enter the school building. Clackmannanshire Council has provided an alcohol based hand sanitiser.
- All pupils are reminded to bring a packed lunch, those who qualify for FSM will be provided with a packed lunch.
- All pupils must remain on the school campus during interval and lunchtime.
- Pupils will not be participating in Physical Education this week so they do not need to bring P.E kit. Further updates will follow.
- Pupils should only bring the materials they require for that day. Pupil lockers will not be in use for the time being. Any pupils who require to access their locker to remove belongings, arrangements will be made.
