

Online Learning Faculty Support for those Self-isolating

Faculty	BGE (S1-S3)	Senior Phase (S4-S6)
<p>Social Subjects</p>	<p>At the beginning of each week your teacher posts information about the learning we will be doing in class. This is put up on Google Classrooms as an “assignment”, with a due date for the end of the week. If you are absent, this is the work that you should complete.</p> <p>However, we do know that it may sometimes be difficult to access and complete work for reasons such as ICT access, family circumstances or illness. In that case you need to message us so that we can put support in place. Remember, we are here to support you!</p> <p>Remember that homework for your class will be posted in a separate “Homework” folder, so please make sure you also complete these tasks as and when required!</p>	<p>Every Google Classroom for senior classes includes a folder for “Revision”. If you are required to self-isolate, you should access materials in this folder to revise content, practice exam skills or close any gaps in your knowledge.</p> <p>Revision materials should be accessed while you wait for your class teacher to assign classwork to you. While this may take a day or two, this classwork will be assigned so that you can continue to learn the content while working from home. It is really important that you stay as up to date with this as possible. However, we do recognise that this may be difficult for reasons such as ICT access, family circumstances or illness. In that case you need to message us so that we can put support in place. Remember, we are here to support you!</p> <p>Remember that homework for your class will be posted in a separate “Homework” folder, so please make sure you also complete these tasks as and when required!</p>
<p>English</p>	<p>Pupils in S1-3 who are self-isolating will be assigned work by their teacher and can access this through their Google Classroom. Staff will contact pupils and assign work as soon as possible, but there may be a small delay between the start of the isolation period and the work being assigned directly. In these circumstances, we would recommend that pupils read for pleasure: novels, short stories, non-fiction texts etc. Reading, alongside exercise, has huge benefits and is especially useful during a period of isolation.</p>	<p>Pupils in S4-6 who are self-isolating will be assigned work by their class teacher. This work will be consolidation of the individual components of the N5 and Higher course: RUAЕ, Scottish Text, Critical Essay and Folio. However, pupils should also use this time to organise their notes and become more familiar with the Scottish Text (characters, themes etc) and their Critical Essay text. If there is still work to do to your Folio this is the ideal time to do so. It is also important to make explicit, however, that we will work with the individual contexts of our pupils - if there are any issues with completing work, just let your class teacher know and we will find a solution.</p>

Modern Languages	Pupils in S1 - 3 who are self-isolating will be assigned work by their class teacher. Additionally, this is also a good opportunity to become more familiar with your French and German vocabulary by learning it from your jotter and by practising it on Linguascope.	Pupils in S4-6 who are self-isolating will be assigned work by their class teacher. However, in the meantime it would also be a good opportunity to learn your vocabulary and also to practise using vocabulary on Linguascope.
Design & Technology	S1/S2 D&T, Design & Man(S3), Eng Science (S3), Graph Comm (S3), Practical Woodworking (S3) Pupils will find work under their Google Classroom class work tab as well as a comment in their class stream with directions about completing the task and what is required.	Design & Man (N4,N5,H,AH), Eng Science (N4,N5,H), Graph Comm (N4,N5,H), Practical Woodworking (N4/N5) Pupils will find work under their Google Classroom class work tab as well as a comment in their class stream with directions about completing the task and what is required. If there are paper based worksheets to be completed for any tasks, C Love will drop these off at home to supplement home learning for self-isolating pupils.
PE	All s1-3 pupils are invited to the BGE classroom. On this there is a "Home Learning" tab where there are a large number of Health and Well-being tasks assigned. Pupils requiring to learn from home are encouraged to scroll through these tasks and complete ones that interest them. Please share photos/updates of your efforts and a member of the PE team will get back to you.	All pupils in the senior phase are invited to google classrooms for their respective courses. Any pupil requiring to work from home should access the "Classwork" tab of the classroom where there are numerous resources under the "Home Learning" and "Class Presentations" sections. All staff will communicate directly via google classroom with pupils home learning for a period of time.
Enterprise	Pupils are routinely using Google Classroom in Enterprise. In each lesson, a note for those working at home is given with regard to what pupils should be doing; a due date is posted to help pupils organise their time. Subject teachers will be in regular contact with pupils either via email or through google classroom; pupils can submit their work using email or via google classroom. In practical classes, the work may differ in terms of what pupils might be doing in school; they may be asked to do an alternative, related, task. This will be clear in the instructions in each lesson.	Pupils are routinely using Google Classroom in Enterprise. In each lesson, a note for those working at home is given with regard to what pupils should be doing; a due date is posted to help pupils organise their time. Subject teachers will be in regular contact with pupils either via email or through google classroom; pupils can submit their work using email or via google classroom.

<p>Creative Arts</p>	<p>Art BGE phase Pupils will find work under the class work tab as well as a comment, and where necessary, a link posted in the class stream to direct pupils towards the task.</p> <p>Music and Music Tech BGE phase Pupils will find work under the class work tab. As the BGE phase classes are grouped per year group, staff will leave a message in the stream with instructions specifically for pupils who are working from home.</p>	<p>Art Senior phase Pupils will find work under the class work tab as well as a comment in the stream with directions about completing the task and what is required. Staff will also either send home their expressive or design folder, whichever is applicable, via C Love.</p> <p>Music and Music Tech Senior phase Pupils will find work in google class under the class work tab and staff will post links and instructions about the tasks in the stream. Where appropriate, if pupils have instruments at home, they should video themselves performing their exam repertoire and send it to their class teacher for feedback.</p>
<p>Maths</p>	<p>The Mathematics Faculty will provide work for the lessons that isolating pupils are missing. The lesson will be posted at the top of the Classwork section of Google Classroom under the topic “Work for Isolating Pupils”. Each lesson will be dated.</p> <p>It will vary depending on the teacher as to whether the lesson will all be posted at the beginning of the week or on the morning of the day of the actual lesson. The lesson will consist of a video or Powerpoint with explanations and worked examples. There will also be exercises provided with answers that pupils should complete and mark. <p>Science</p>	<p>At the beginning of each week your work will be put up on Google Classrooms as an “assignment”, with a due date for the end of the week. If you are absent, this is the work that you should complete.</p> <p>If you are finding it difficult to access and complete work for reasons such as ICT access, family circumstances or illness please message your teacher so that they can put support in place.</p> <p>Homework for your class will be posted under a separate “Homework” heading, so make sure you also complete these tasks as and when required.</p>	<p>Most Google Classrooms for senior classes includes a heading for self-isolating pupils. If not you should be aware of how to find your work. If not contact your class teacher in the first instance.</p> <p>Work will be posted regularly by your teacher. This may take a day or two once we know that you are isolating so until then you can access revision materials.</p> <p>It is important that you try to stay as up to date with this as possible. If this is proving to be difficult for any reason such as ICT access, family circumstances or illness message us so that we can put support in place.</p> <p>Homework for your class will be posted under a separate “Homework” heading, so make sure you also complete these as and when required.</p>
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
