SCHOOL UNIFORM

I trust you had a pleasant long weekend and that you and your loved ones are safe and well.

With the current school year drawing to a close, I know that many families will already be thinking about school uniform for next year. School uniform is important as it helps promote equity, engenders a sense of belonging and a work ethic, and helps us maintain school security. I am providing some information and advice that will, I hope, be helpful. I am eager that we maintain high standards of dress at school, as I know you are too.

A reminder that our school uniform consists of the following:

Acceptable uniform

Black blazer
School tie
White shirt
Black skirt/trousers
Plain black jumper/cardigan
School hoodie or zipper (must have school badge)
Black shoes

Unacceptable uniform

Any clothing not in school colours
Jumpers with name of manufacturer displayed prominently
Jumpers displaying large logos
Hooded tops (other than standard uniform 'hoodie')
Jeans, especially ripped jeans
Leggings
Sports wear
Leather/leather effect waistcoats
Tracksuit trousers or tops

In consultation with our pupils, we are introducing a school 'hoodie' and school zipper top for next session (see above link for images). Only school hoodies should be worn to school – any other types of hooded top are not permitted.

PE Kit and school ties can be purchased in school. Items such as trousers, shirts, jumpers and cardigans can be purchased from most high street retailers and many large supermarkets.
